## Gurkhas kill woman Red at 80 yards

In the Baling district of Sungei Patani in Kedah, a patrol found the body of a terrorist who had been killed

KUALA LUMPUR, Mon. A WOMAN terrorist has been killed by a Gurkha patrol in the Sungei Raja area of Ipoh, in Perak. She was hit at 80 yards range across a river.

Two other terrorists escaped. The body of a dead terrorist, who had been wounded by a hunting party the day before,

was found by a Home Guard patrol in the Tapah area on Saturday

In the Baling district of Sungei Patani in Kedah, a patrol found the body of a terrorist who had been killed on Oct. 6 by a comrade, who has since surrendered.

A terrorist gave up to a Malay tapper on Braemar Estate in the Kajang district of Selangor on Saturday.

Two Chinese tappers in Semantan Estate, in the Mentakab area of Pahang, were murdered by terrorists on a Friday. One was stabbed while the other was shot.
